

Swartz Ambulance EMS Education Program
Emergency Medical Technician-Basic Course

Approved by MDHHS, Bureau of EMS and Trauma Preparedness, Approval Number: B-20-3351

This course is taught by professionals in the emergency care field and will provide the fundamental working knowledge for the Emergency Medical Technician-Basic.

Topics covered will include:

Roles and Responsibilities of the EMT; Medical Legal Considerations; EMS Systems Operations; Communications – Legal Documentation; Patient Assessment; Anatomy and Physiology; Triage; Respiratory Emergencies; Chest Injuries; Airway Management; Oxygen Therapy; Shock; Patient Handling; Cardiovascular Disease; Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation – Professional Level; AED; Central Nervous System; Other Traumatic Injuries; Bleeding and Soft Tissue Injuries; Musculoskeletal Injuries; Facial Injuries; Abdominal Injuries; Burns; Acute abdomen; Diabetes; Communicable Disease; Behavioral Emergencies; Poisons, Substance Abuse; Geriatric Patient; Obstetrical/Gynecological Emergencies; Pediatrics; Environment Emergencies; Hazardous Material; Stress Management; Rescue – Extrication; Hazardous Materials Awareness

A minimum of 80 hours clinical time on a BLS/ALS ambulance in an Emergency Room setting will be required in addition to the scheduled class times.

We will pay you a wage while taking this course and offer you continued employment once you become licensed. You may also work in our wheelchair division while taking this class.

Persons successfully completing this course will be eligible for the National Registry Examinations which is the State of Michigan License examination.

Pre-Requisites: You must be 18 years of age (or be 18 prior to licensing exam); Negative TB skin test; Proof of Hepatitis B series vaccination.

Textbooks and National Registry Exam Fees are also included.
